- 2. Stationery Bank Setup:**
  - Schools that apply are provided with a Stationery Bank, containing items such as pencils, pens, erasers, sharpeners, glue sticks, certificates, award medals, and whistles.
- 3. Classroom Discipline:**
  - Whistles are provided to help teachers maintain discipline. For instance:
    - First whistle: Students quiet down.
    - Second whistle: Full silence, enabling effective communication.
- 4. Student Responsibility:**
  - Students are taught to value and not misuse the supplies.
  - Capable students are encouraged to contribute stationery on their birthdays or during festivals.
